# Attire:

# **Transportation:**

Transportation to and from the Day Camp site is the responsibility of the parents and the pack. Car pools are encouraged and are part of the fun.

# Lunch:

Each camper and staff member will be responsible for bringing his or her own bagged lunch.

There is NO refrigeration on site. However, there will be coolers available for storage of lunches.

Please send your child with a refillable water bottle. Lunch is scheduled around noon each day and will last approximately 30 minutes and then be followed by some type of "quiet time activity" which usually lasts approximately 30 minutes. Any parent is welcome to come in and have lunch with their child, but all campers are to remain in camp during lunch.

# **Special Needs:**

If you have a Scout with special needs please inform the Day Camp Director and offer suggestions to assist the scout in completing as much of the program as he can.

# **Health Forms:**

Anyone (youth and adults) participating in Day Camp MUST submit a current BSA medical form (Parts A and B). Please send this form when registering, but no later than the week before camp.

Scouts will not be allowed to attend without this form. A Camp Health Officer will be on hand for first aid (not medical treatment) and to oversee the administration of any medications needed during day camp hours.
